



POLICE REPORT

WEST LINTON COMMUNITY COUNCIL

February 2010

Since the last Community Council meeting, a total of 12 calls have been received by police regarding incidents in the West Linton area.

This is broken down as follows –

2 x Alarm activation (all false)

2 x reports of other road traffic related problems (obstructions of the roadway etc)

5 x miscellaneous calls for police assistance

3 x Road traffic collisions

During the early hours of 1st January, 2 windows were smashed at the Graham Institute, West Linton. Following police enquiries into this incident, a 17 year old male has been detected for this crime. A report has been submitted to the procurator fiscal.

Following a disturbance in Broomlee Road, West Linton, a 58 year old woman and a 55 year old male have been found to be responsible. Both have been charged with a Breach of the Peace and issued with Anti Social Behaviour Fixed Penalty Notices.

Overnight from the 1st into the 2nd February 2010, a trailer was stolen from outside a house in St Mungos Place, West Linton. Police enquiries are continuing.

As a result of police enquiries, a 17 year old male has been charged with an assault which took place in Broomlee Road, West Linton. A report has been prepared for the procurator fiscal.
